

Intended use:

Use these mandala elements in your next art project. Simply print them out on ordinary printer paper and cut out the shape/s you wish to use. Turn the cut out over and coat the cut out in chalkboard chalk. Place the cut out, chalk side down, where you want to trace the design on your project. Hold or tape in place. Use a dotting stylus, pen, or pencil to go over the design. When complete lift the cut out to reveal the design. Use a test area on your surface to be sure the chalk wipes off clean. Print these pages as often as you like.
